

FAQ: Guided Learning for Kindergarten and Grade 1

What is Guided Learning?

Sask DLC offers a high-quality, fully funded online Kindergarten and Grade 1 program taught by certified Saskatchewan teachers. The Guided Learning model combines live online classes with independent, hands-on activities, following the Ministry of Education curriculum.

What does the daily schedule look like?

The schedule includes a blend of live (synchronous) class time and independent (asynchronous) activities.

- Students join scheduled live sessions focusing on reading, writing and math.
- Additional activities are provided for flexible completion at home.

Note: The exact schedule may change slightly depending on enrolment and class needs.

Are students sitting at a computer in live meetings all day?

No. Students will have balance live meeting time with the teacher and their peers and independent learning complete offline or outside of live sessions.

Is all schoolwork completed during class time?

Not entirely. A balance allows for both structure and flexibility in your child's day.

- Live class time focuses on connection, guided instruction and interactive learning.
- Some activities are designed to be completed outside of class with family support.

What is asynchronous learning?

Asynchronous learning includes simple, play-based activities that children complete offline or outside of live sessions. These activities are flexible and designed to fit into your family's routine. They may include:

- Hands-on play and exploration
- Simple literacy or numeracy activities
- Creative tasks like drawing, building or storytelling

What happens if my child misses a day?

That's okay. The focus is on engagement, socialization and building a love of learning, not falling behind.

- There is no formal "catch-up" required.
- Learning is ongoing and repetitive.
- Students can rejoin the next session without stress.

What is my role as a parent or caregiver?

Parents play an important supporting role by:

- Helping their child log into live sessions
- Supporting or guiding independent activities
- Encouraging participation and routine

You are not expected to replace the teacher, but your involvement helps create a successful learning experience.
